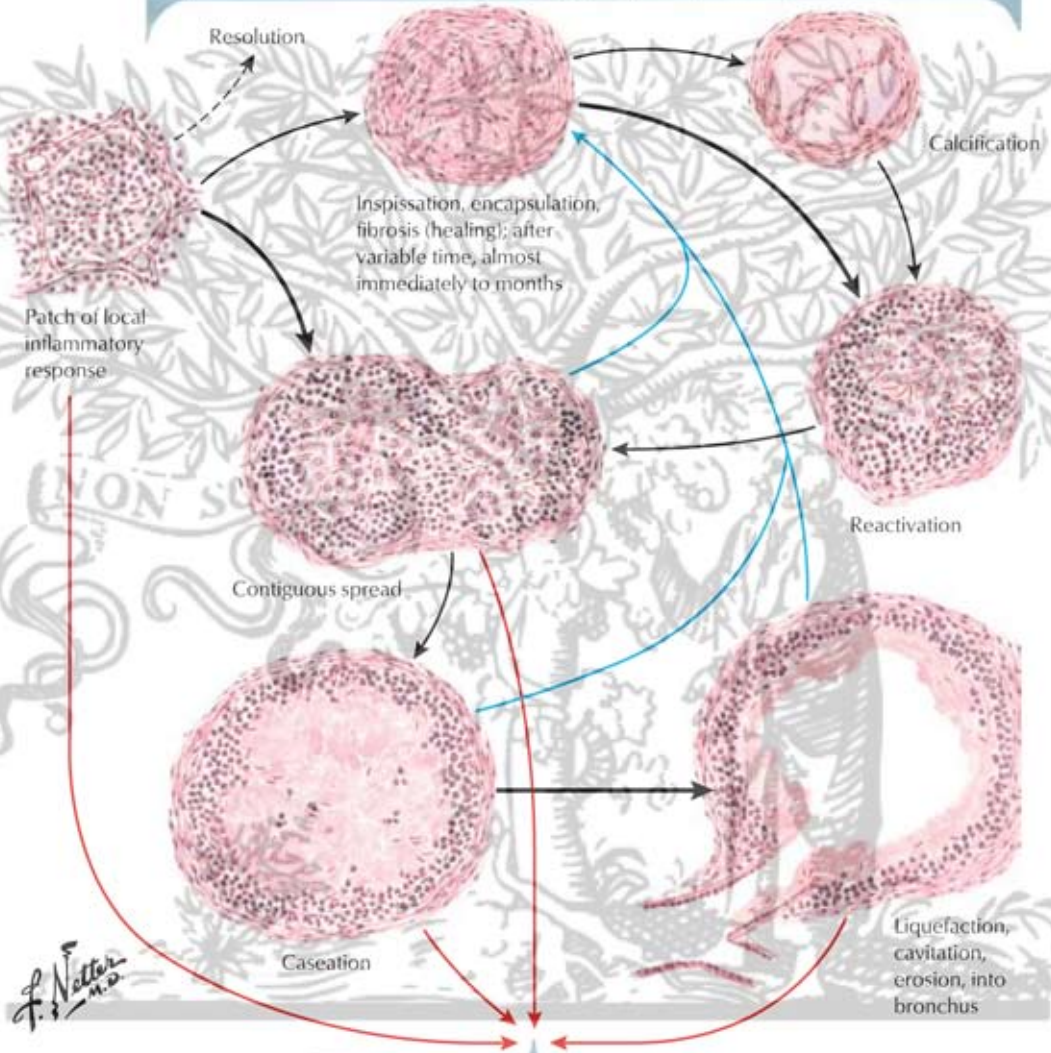
Virulence and number of infecting organisms

Natural and acquired immunity of host

Age (newborn, 15 to 30 years, and elderly most susceptible), race, malnutrition, alcoholism, pregnancy

Silicosis, diabetes, other debilitating diseases; gastrectomy

Chemotherapy (adequacy thereof)



Dissemination in same or to distant organ
